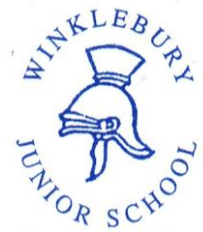

- * Specialist LSA support including:
 - social skills
 - speech and language
 - nurture
 - ELSA
 - motor skills
- * 1:1 interventions in English and maths to enable children to 'catch up' and meet age-related expectations
- * T and I support in English and maths to enable children to 'keep up' and meet age-related expectations

- * Subsidies for:
 - off site activities and visitors
 - Year 5 and 6 residential
 - after school curriculum enrichment clubs
 - breakfast club
- * Targeted workshops for parents
