Events for Year 6 leavers

I am writing to tell you about events for our Year 6 children up to the end of term.

We have organised a party for the Year 6 leavers on **Thursday 20th July 4.30 to 6.00pm**. There will be no charge. We will provide food and drinks and Mr Gannaway, Miss Hoyle and Mrs Murphy are organising games on the field. Your child should return to school for 4.30pm and make his/her way to the school hall via the outside hall doors. He/she does not have to wear school uniform but should have footwear that is safe in which to play games such as rounders.

You are invited to join us for the children's 'leavers' assembly' on **Thursday 20th July at 9.15am**. The year group are preparing a presentation for you and each of the children will be presented with a 'leaving certificate' and a small gift to mark their time at Winklebury Juniors. Please make sure your child is in their smartest school uniform with school shoes for this special occasion.

On the last day of term the **Year 6 children may get a shirt signed** during the day. PLEASE NOTE children must bring a different shirt in for signing. For example they could bring in a school polo shirt or their P.E. t-shirt for signing. No child will be allowed to collect signatures on the shirt they are wearing for the day.

We are also planning a **special lunch for Year 6 on the last day of term** and invite the children to bring in a contribution of buffet food that can be shared e.g. sausage rolls, sandwiches, biscuits, crisps, cakes. Please avoid products with nuts due to allergies. We will provide drinks.

The last day of term can be a particularly exciting time for Year 6 leavers from a school and I do not want anything to mar this special day for the children. We will talk to them, but we would also appreciate your support in stressing to the children that their last day is important and must not be spoiled by any 'pranks' or situations that they will look back on and regret.
