

Easter Challenges

Here are some activities to try over the Easter holidays.
But more importantly, have fun and enjoy!

Make some Easter treats to share with your family. You could make chocolate nests, cakes or biscuits and decorate them too!



Try some planting activities. You could plant some seeds in a flowerpot filled with soil. Make sure to give them some water and put them in a sunny place.

Decorate some hard-boiled eggs, to make them bright and colourful. You could use pens or paint and add some extra decorations, such as stickers, feathers, pom-poms, glitter or googly eyes.

Bunny starts with the letter 'b' - what else starts with the letter 'b'? Write a list of things that start with 'b'. How many things can you think of?

Make an Easter basket to keep your Easter eggs safe. You could use empty cardboard boxes and add some decorations too.



Draw or paint an Easter picture - you could draw some Easter eggs, flowers, chicks or even an Easter bunny!

The Easter Bunny is great at hiding eggs. Can you play a hiding game with your family? Choose something to hide in your home or garden and ask someone to find it. Can you think of any clues to give them?



Egg starts with the letter 'e' - what else starts with the letter 'e'? Write a list of things that start with 'e'. How many things can you think of?

Can you draw a large egg shape and decorate it with colourful patterns? You could use pens, paint or pencils.

If there are 10 eggs in a basket and then 5 get eaten, how many would be left in the basket? You could use your fingers or draw a picture to help you.
